Revised MAPP-Policy

Donna Bertolino presented the revised policy initiated by the College Math GPA pilot and fusion courses. Some minor revisions were suggested by the committee and the policy was approved as revised.

At the request of Chuck Phair the program requirements for A.S. Business Management: Hospitality Option and Business Management: Hospitality Certificate were reviewed. Although these programs were not officially inactivated, it appears they do need revision before they could be opened for enrollment:

The AS degree would need to be evaluated and likely revised to meet CAS and transfer requirements.
