UPDATES

Update on El-Hefni Allied Health & Tech Center – Scheduled to be ready for use in Spring 2014.

Update on the Registry Lot – The work on the registry building lot is on hold with the foundation until after their May meeting.

Library Update – Construction documents in process for the two story library plan.

Mass Development Grant Application Update – The application has been submitted.

Mass Works Grant – Work on this grant anticipated to begin again this summer.

420 Common Street Update – The basement will house maintenance, public safety offices and storage. ***Update on work with Lawrence Public Schools:**

4/3/13 – LW met with Shalimar Quiles. LPS has been in recovery mode; organizing, assessing, and planning. Over the next few weeks they have planned a couple of key hires including a Director of Guidance who will oversee the counselors across the district and provide a measure of standardization and a Scholar Reengagement Specialist to fill Shalimar’s position as Shalimar will assume the duties formerly held by Superintendent Jeff Riley’s chief of staff, Marilse Rodriguez-Garcia. When the positions are filled their goal is to put a concerted effort into the high school which includes partnering with NECC in any number of ways; partnership activities could start as early as the 2014-2015 school year. Shalimar and Lori to reconvene late spring, early summer 2013 to discuss next steps. Additionally, Phoenix Academy Lawrence (an alternative school for grades 9-12, run by Phoenix Charter School) may be interested in doing what sounds like a contract course and this could serve as a pilot/model for the district. Lori to reach out to Olivia Lahann, Head of School for more information.

5/13/13 – LPS has appointed an Acting Scholar Reengagement Specialist, Leldamy Correa. Leldamy and Lori Weir to meet Tuesday, May 14, 2013. Other updates; Ellen and Lori working with Wendy Shaffer on a PIF grant involving Lawrence; Next PK-12 Collaborations Team meeting 5/17 to discuss current and planned activity and resources for future activity.
