NexDine Update:

- If you get a better price quote from another company, NexDine will meet/beat that quote.
- Issues that have arisen: NexDine getting back to people in a timely matter, picking up used dishes and equipment within a reasonable time frame.
- Food needs to be labeled so people know what is available.
- We have received great feedback about the new look to Jitters.
- If you are going to go out and use your own caterer, you must contact Allison Gagne to coordinate set up/break down times, pick-ups, ect...
- There will be a meeting of the food service committee and another meeting with representatives from NexDine to stay abreast of ongoing issues and how to improve.

Rydin/Parking Policy Update:

- David is meeting with All College Assembly Finance committee to speak with them in regards to questions and concerns raised about the parking policy. He is willing to go to any meetings on campus to explain everything that is happening with the policy.
- We will not put parking fines on student's accounts that would prevent them from graduating, registering for classes.
- Policy will be implemented on January 1, 2014. Stickers will be available online starting around the middle of October.
- Possible ways to get parking policy information out to students: posters, handouts in classrooms, text alerts.
- There will be 24/7 security across from the Buckley Garage in the Amesbury Street Building.

Follett Bookstore/Food Update:

- Bookstore is going to take up the walled off space upstairs in the Student Center. Doors on both hallways.
- Bookstore will have a small coffee shop
- Bookstore in 420 Common will be installed on October 23/24. Grand Opening possibly in November.
- Plans for 420 Common will have Sal's, frozen yogurt shop, and a bank.

Lawrence Campus Food Update:

- Sal's satellite location in Lawrence feedback: hours are limited, don't have enough lunch options (students had more choices with clock tower), no Latino breakfast options. Pizza is expensive at \$4 a slice.
- David, Allison, and Martha will be meeting with Joe Bevilacqua from Lupoli Group to discuss.

Shuttles:

- MVRTA shuttles are running well. They added another bus at 9AM at 420 Common to accommodate overflow of students.
- Shuttles would like to limit the boxes they carry back and forth between campuses due to lack of room on the buses.
