1. Lawrence Campus Facilities Update

- Current plans for ISE in Lawrence were reviewed (see attached Powerpoint; updated from this morning by removing references to 420 Common decision)
- extensive discussion on what L100 mini-Hub (and surrounding areas) would include next year
 - important next step is to get more specific about staffing issues: in particular, Stephanie and other relevant unit leaders need to weigh in on what is feasible
- potential structural changes to create a complete Hub in Fall 2020 were discussed
- Library plans were described including moving the open computer lab to L149
- need for further discussion identified around waiting areas for students for both the Center for Adult Education and Coaching/Tutoring on the second floor of Dimitry
- classroom issues discussed

2. Team Updates:

- Academic Centers
 - getting ready for priority registration, general registration: emails, pathways
- Pathways
 - data analysis of the effectiveness of course sequences, toxic combinations needed
- Student Success Hub
 - L100 Mini-Hub plans discussed
 - EAB soft launch in April, mainly for advising and financial aid staff
- Advising Reform
 - some problems identified with students getting texts related to priority registration
