**1. Data and the ISE: Kelly Saretsky (guest)**

**Presentation:**

- We already have BAGS (Big Ass Goals) for the ISE: Course completion, fall to fall retention, three year success metric
- but how do we measure micro goals: increase student sense of belonging, structure, integration of services?
- suggested process: today an introduction
  - 2 hour measurement design session in April
  - then a "gallery" to get feedback from employees/students on the design measures before the end of the semester

- Stem Starter Academy Grant resources available to help: existing student survey; \$15K Donahue Institute consultants; Donahue helps design surveys?
- how do we use existing data in the design process?
- homework for two hour meeting? Talk to others for ideas about measures of the three micro goals listed above
- can we measure levels of belonging? Is belonging REALLY the right word?
- do we need a student scan? THEIR definition of belonging? Need a student gallery?
  - connection RATHER than belonging?
