1. 2019 Review and 2020 Look Ahead
 - a. 2020 will be a busy year.

 - e. There is an ongoing request to have Financial Aid representatives in the centers. Kelly is working with Jennifer to provide data and personnel as needed.
 - f. The Communications sub-team will begin working with the Navigate communications team to communicate to the college community on upcoming changes.
 - g. Question of use of the scheduling tool for faculty. Bill discussed paid training for faculty.
 - h. Faculty workloads may be adjusted regarding advisees.
