

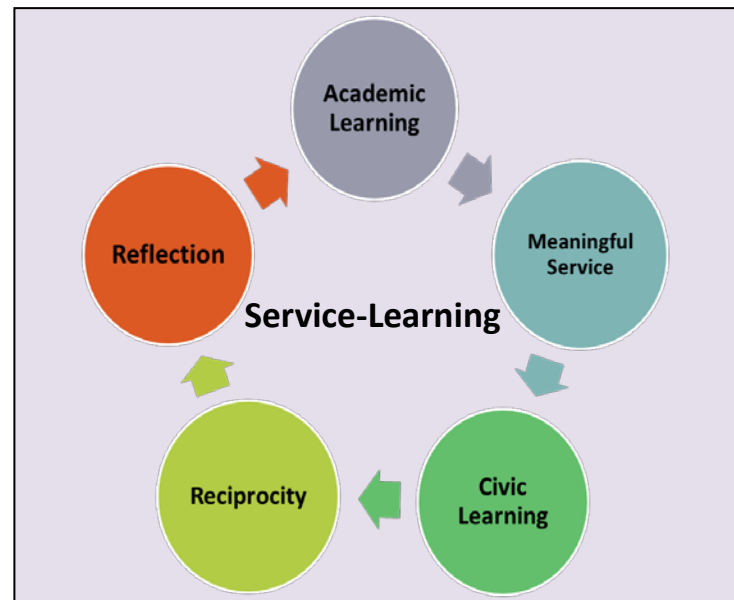
Service-Learning at Northern Essex Community College ...
