1. Summer/Fall Planning for College Operations and impact on the ISE
 - a. Will possibly make investment to online course development for summer and fall
 - b. Still working on remote registration
 - c. Students appear to like registering remotely
 - d. Question of some staff being back on campus in the summer
 - e. Zoom has provided opportunities to pull students in
2. Update on Registration for summer/fall
 - a. To date, summer registration is up
 - b. Will most likely cancel a lot of face to face courses for the summer I session
 - c. Fall registration appears to be lower but it is evolving
 - d. Concern about testing being available to students remotely; TEAS is not yet available
 - e. Is it possible to have a checklist for the packets for Health so that students are assured that they have complete packets
 - f. Advising has seen a slow down as well
 - g. Student Affairs is creating an online orientation program for students
 - h. Discussion of maintaining relationships between students and advisors
 - i. Provide a "Know your Network" so students know who to contact when they have a question or problem
 - j. Question of allowing faculty to choose those advisees that they have a relationship with
3. Team Updates
 - a. Pathways/Navigate
 - i. Starting the one click registration build process
 - ii. In 4 – 6 months, students will be able to register in Navigate; for new students
 - b. Academic Centers
 - i. Professional Studies had zoom meetups early on but will not have one with the end of the semester coming up
 - ii. Students like online registration and advising
 - iii. Registration has slowed down in the business area
 - iv. Question of students not passing their spring classes; will they be put on probation or suspension?
 - v. If students fall below 2.0 GPA they will be put on probation and should not register for more than 2 classes
 - vi. Financial Aid requirements becoming flexible with the CARES Act
