1. CARES Act
  - a. NECC was awarded 1.6 million dollars
  - b. There is approximately 500K left to award to students for the fall semester
  - c. 1,314 students have received funding to date
  - d. The laptop initiative funding will come from CARES Act
  - e. Non-matriculated students are not eligible
2. Team Updates
  - a. Pathways/Navigate
    - i. Working with EAB on developing one click registration
    - ii. Still working on a process to show pre-requisites for courses
    - iii. Tutoring is up and running with appointment scheduling
  - b. Academic Centers
